## **REHIS Northern Centre Amplitude Modulation Workshop Aberdeen (Committee Room 5, Woodhill House) Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> March 2017**

The Northern Centre in conjunction with Hoare Lea Acoustics have put together a full day workshop following the recent publication of the Institute of Acoustics Methodology on AM noise from wind turbines. The workshop will discuss how the method was developed and how it is best used by EHO's dealing with wind turbines.

The day will be in a workshop format, based on examples where possible to allow the best practical application of assessing AM noise using worked examples and anonymous case studies where possible. The session will be a workshop style format so that debate is stimulated and a common consensus can be developed on the use of the method, under the direction of a leading expert in this field.
