The REHIS Advanced HACCP (Level 4) course which is run in conjunction with Campden BRI is designed to provide knowledge and skills to design and implement food safety management systems based upon the Codex HACCP principles.

Following the three days of tuition, course participants undertake a HACCP assignment which forms part of the course assessment. Successful completion of the assignment allows course participants to sit the course examination which will be held in early August 2017.
