## **REHIS Regulations**

- Centres and Presenters must be <u>approved</u> by REHIS before they can deliver any REHIS qualifications
- Change of centre contacts and presenters notified to REHIS
- All courses must be registered with REHIS by the Approved Centre
- Presenters must deliver the full syllabus/provide set course packs to candidates
- Centres are subject to periodic quality assurance visits by REHIS




